

**EXHIBIT E**  
**DESCRIPTION OF MISSION SUPPORT**

In consideration of the grant of faculty appointments, sponsorship and administration of undergraduate and graduate medical education programs, sponsorship and support for research initiatives, and overall enhancement of the institutional mission of Saint Luke's Hospital of Kansas City ("SLH") by the University of Kansas through its Schools of Medicine, Nursing and Allied Health ("University") as referenced in the Affiliation Agreement between SLH and the University effective \_\_\_\_\_, 2007 ("Affiliation Agreement"), SLH is committed to offering to the University and the greater Kansas City community the following forms of mission support.

- SLH will provide the University with not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per year in unrestricted mission support for the first four (4) years of the initial term of the Affiliation Agreement to be paid in equal quarterly installments on the last day of each calendar quarter.
- After the first four (4) years of the initial term of the Affiliation Agreement, SLH will negotiate in good faith with the University on an annual basis to arrive at a mutually appropriate amount of annual unrestricted mission support during the remainder of the initial term and any subsequent renewal terms of the Affiliation Agreement. As part of such annual negotiations, SLH will provide the University with documentation of the mission support it offers to other educational institutions and medical schools with which it is also affiliated.
- In addition to the unrestricted mission support described above, SLH will enter into good faith negotiations with the University on an ad hoc, project-by-project basis as to the level of financial and in-kind commitment it will offer to major collaborative projects that may be proposed by the University from time to time.
- SLH will maintain financial support for its established medical education and clinical research programs as well as its community service/medical education clinics on the SLH campus throughout the initial term of the Affiliation Agreement consistent with then-current SLH annual budgetary guidelines; provided, however, that the support for such programs for the first four (4) years of the initial term of the Affiliation Agreement shall be at a minimum aggregate level of Fifteen Million Dollars (\$15,000,000.00) per year. Thereafter, SLH will confer with the University on an annual basis to develop a level of financial commitment to such programs and clinics that is consistent with community needs and then-current SLH budgetary guidelines.
